Workin' on a Full House

It may be an ordinary rental, but at one time, a country superstar lived here. By Kristen McConnaughey

THIS UNASSUMING YELLOW two-story house is the former home of one of the most successful music stars of all time. This native son got his start in his home state, and it's the place he still calls home today.

After moving to the sleepy town for college, the soon-to-be singer lived here after getting his degree in advertising—and after getting hitched. Although the newlyweds only lived in this rental for one year in the late 1980s, it was here that the singer composed music and had jam sessions before soaring to the top of the charts in 1989.

Located at 227 South Duck Street near downtown, the 1,600-square-foot house is mere blocks from a certain jumpin' little juke joint. Except for a newly added back porch, the residence hasn't changed much

since the two-time Grammy Award-winner called it home. Now owned by a family trust, the neighborhood landmark continues to be rented out year after year.
